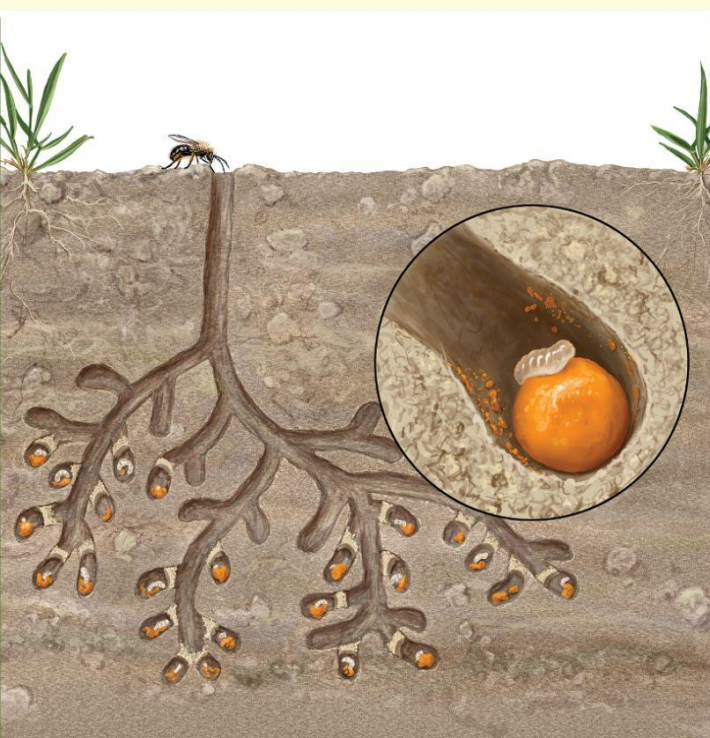


Ground Nesting Bees

What to look for:

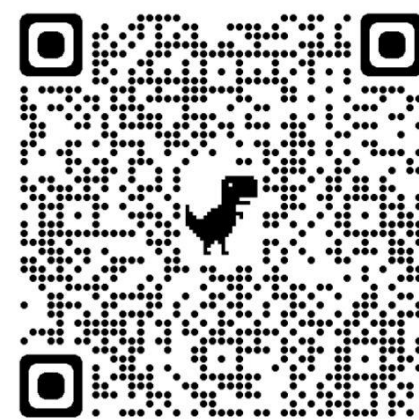
Many bees nest in large aggregations. Monitor flight activity in the early spring through late summer.

Entrances in grass and soil are indicators of bee activity.
